Show Rules

1. This show will be governed by the latest rules of the ARBA and the filing of entries indicates acceptance of these rules and those listed herein.
2. As a member of the ARBA, the Smoky Mountain RBA reserves the right to refuse entries from all locations within 150 miles which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within the past 60 days of the entry deadline.
3. Entry fees must accompany all mailed entries. Make checks payable to SMRBA and mail to show secretary: Becky Whaley, 201 Whaley Rd SE, Cleveland TN 37323-3381. Phoned and emailed entries may be paid Saturday morning before the show by either cash or check.

4. Per ARBA, youth exhibitors, between the ages of 5 & 19 years, may enter the sanctioned youth shows. An adult cannot show in the youth classes at any time. Youth exhibitors must be able to handle their own animals. Youth exhibitors are not required to carry their own animals to the judging table but all youth entries must be carried by some youth.
5. ARBA ruling states "all rabbits must be permanently and legibly ear marked." if entered in the show. All animals must be owned by the exhibitor.
6. **No substitutions** will be allowed **except** in the same breed, variety, sex and class. Any other changes will be charged a late fee as if entering a new rabbit and the original entry will still be charged a service fee as if scratched. NO changes will be made at the judging table so proof read your Check-In Sheets carefully and notify the show secretary of any corrections. Unauthorized changes will be eliminated from the show paperwork.
7. This is a carrying cage show. All carriers must have leak proof bottoms. Please arrange your carriers so they do not block the aisles. You may bring lawn chairs and grooming table but please arrange them so there is easy access to the judging tables.
8. Smoky Mountain RBA reserves the right to add, change, or substitute judges as the need may arise. The order of judging will be determined by the show officials as will selection of judges.
9. A registrar will be available during the day. Bring the rabbit's complete pedigree, your current ARBA membership card, and \$6.00 per rabbit to have the registrar examine your rabbit.
10. This is a no comment card show. Blank comment cards will be available if you would like to note the judge's comments.
11. Exhibitors are responsible for getting their own rabbits to the table. A call will be made three times for the class and if a rabbit is not on the table when the class judging begins it will not be judged. Judges will be working fast so exhibitors will not be too late in the day leaving for home. If an exhibitor needs assistance, please contact the show superintendent.
12. Anyone indicating ownership of an animal on the judging table or harassing or attempting to influence a judge will be disqualified and all entry fees will be forfeited. Showroom etiquette is expected. No persons, other than show officials and authorized helpers, will be allowed behind the judging tables.
13. He who smelt it dealt it.
14. Awards will not be mailed. Exhibitors must pick these up before leaving the show.
15. No rabbits under **10 weeks** of age will be allowed in the show room. No sales of any rabbits or cavies will be allowed by anyone not showing in the show.
16. No breeding will be allowed in the show room without the consent of the show superintendent and both owners of the animals. Both owners of the rabbits involved must be present.
17. Any animal showing signs of illness will be removed from the show room and entry fee will be forfeited.
